Growth for Home Support Services in its 20th year

Home Support Service has been able to triple its staff and expand interstate thanks to a coordinated push for in-home care to help free up hospital beds.

The 20-year-old, Parkside-based firm provides in-home hospital care for more than 20,000 South Australians each year and now employs 300 staff across two States.

"The recent growth of the company coincided with the opening of an office on the Gold Coast, where it now employs 30 staff," says MD, Virginia Bullock.

"In June last year we successfully tendered for a contract to operate the Queensland Government-funded Home Health Link program on the Gold Coast.

"Under this program we provide rapid response short-term support and assistance for people in their own home. It has also allowed us to expand our other services into Queensland where we see great potential.

"This is a pilot program which has the potential to be rolled out across Queensland and once complete we could boost our staff numbers in Queensland considerably.

"We're also considering other expansion opportunities along the eastern seaboard, but they're very much in the preliminary planning stage. We continue to receive strong demand for our services in SA."
